### Highlights

- The paper studies the effect of temporary schooling interruption on starting wages in Canada.
- The identification strategy is based on Lewbel's (2012) generated instruments approach.
- The impact of out-of-school periods on post-graduation wages differs across gender.
- This impact also depends on the activity undertaken during the interruption.
- We run a number of alternative specifications including two-stage quantile regressions.



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
