## Highlights

- We analyze longitudinal worker/establishment data from Korea from 2008-09 to 2012-13.
- Job stayers experience frequent (infrequent) nominal wage reductions (freezes).
- A majority of employers cut a fraction of their workers' wages fairly routinely.
- Employers tend to 'choose' high wage earners for wage cuts.
