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Pneumothorax associated with acupuncture: A systematic review and analysis

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ABSTRACT

Objective: To review and analyze pneumothorax associated with acupuncture worldwide. *Methods*: We searched MEDLINE, PUBMED, NHS, CNKI(China), VIP(China) and WanFang(China) using the MeSH terms "acupuncture" and "complications/adverse events/side effect" and "pneumothorax" for eligible articles. We included and analyzed all original case reports, reviews and prospective studies. *Results*: There are 37 Chinese articles and 40 articles in other languages published with case report which reported 128 cases and 51 cases with pneumothorax induced by acupuncture, respectively. There are 24 articles with prospective studys or reviews. pneumothorax is the most common among the all severe adverse events related to acupuncture. However, acupuncture is an important cause of pneumothorax which is missing from the western medical books.

Conclusions: Acupuncture should be emphasized and listed in the western medical textbooks as an iatrogenic cause to pneumothorax.

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Acupuncture is an ancient procedure that has been practiced in China for thousands of years. Since the late 1970's, acupuncture has gained significant popularity worldwide. Western medical acupunture involves the use of points to cause neural stimulation, which is proposed to block the pain gate control mechanism and to cause the production of endorphins [1]. More recently, it has gradually won acceptance in western countries as an alternative or complementary treatment for various conditions, including chronic pain syndrome [2–6]. A US study showed that among family practice patients who used Chinese medicine, 16% used acupuncture [7]. Family physicians use acupuncture for pain management, for

musculoskeletal conditions [8], for cancer [9], and for postoperative conditions [10,11]. Because of its widespread use, the safety of acupuncture is of increasing importance. In the past few years, adverse events associated with acupuncture treatment in foreign countries have been published in the form of systematic reviews or surveys [12-14]. In Norway, questionnaires were conducted among 1135 randomly selected doctors and 197 acupuncturists in 1995. 33 cases of pneumothorax occurred [15]. In 2000, the survey in Australia from 1100 traditional Chinese medical practioners showed that 64 cases got pneumothorax after acupuncture [16]. However, acupuncture didn't get enough concern as one cause of iatrogenic pneumothorax so far in many countries, the cases with pneumothorax by acupuncture occur now and then. With this background, our objective was to systematically review the existing literature that reported or studied the cases with pneumothorax induced to acupuncture.
