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**ABSTRACT** 

Heavy metals can significantly bioaccumulate in fish tissues, the step wise mechanism of

heavy metal toxicities on fish health is still limited. Present study assessed the tissue-specific

namely, Channa striatus and Heteropneustes fossilis inhabiting Kali river of northern India

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
