Introduction: Retroperitoneal ectopic pregnancy (REP) is a rare type of gestation that is difficult to diagnose and treat

. To date, only several published cases are available and no specific guideline has been developed to manage this disease. As the lesions are located closely to the large retroperitoneal blood vessels, surgical resection of the gestational tissue might incur risks such as associated hemorrhage, injury of blood vessels or nerves.
