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HIGHLIGHTS

- Laryngeal chondrosarcoma is an uncommon tumor and therefore, there is no established diagnostic and treatment approach for this tumor
- 90% of laryngeal chondrosarcoma are low-grade tumors and therefore conservative surgery is recommended as initial treatment
- Percutaneous biopsy could select which patients could be candidates for a less radical treatment instead of total laryngectomy

KEY LEARNING POINTS

- 1. The laryngeal chondrosarcoma is a very rare neoplasm
- 2. Surgery is the only curative treatment for this tumor
- 3. Unlike the epidermoid carcinoma, due to its pattern of dissemination and the survival rate, this tumors can be treated with a less invasive surgery trying to

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
