Highlights

- Early childhood adversities are linked with PD symptoms in adulthood
- Malnutrition is linked with paranoid, schizoid, avoidant, and dependent PDs
- Maltreatment is linked with paranoid, schizoid, avoidant, and schizotypal PDs
- Overall, those exposed to both adversities had even higher PD scores
- Interventions should focus on immediate and long-term outcomes
