ACCEPTED MANUSCRIPT

Highlights:

- Both inattentiveness (IN) and hyperactivity/impulsivity (HI) dimensions of ADHD were related with the severity of IA symptoms
- Presence of probable ADHD was related with the severity of IA symptoms
- Particularly non-accept dimension of the Difficulties in Emotion Regulation Scale predicted IA
- ADHD was related with IA even after controlling difficulties in emotion regulation, anxiety, depression and neuroticism
