Highlights

- The link between childhood traumatic experiences and adult obesity is demonstrated.
- Adult obesity is specifically related to emotional abuse and emotional neglect.
- BED patients display higher emotional neglect and abuse than other groups.
- Clinical and therapeutic perspectives for BED should be revised accordingly.
