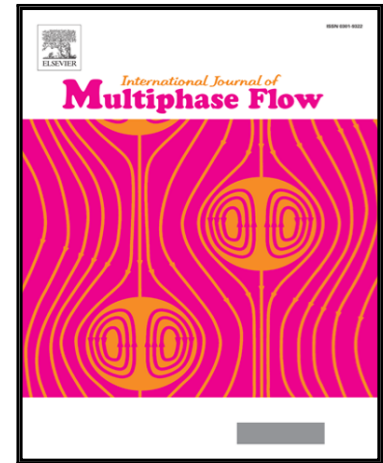


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Effect of flow geometry on the evolution of concentrated suspensions flowing through a fracture

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Highlights

- Small variations in concentration lead to persistent and significant velocity variations
- Velocity-field hysteresis results as flow field becomes increasingly three dimensional
- Changes in flow rate equilibrate much more quickly than the corresponding pressure gradient

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
