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

Nerve ultrasound findings differentiate Charcot-Marie-Tooth disease (CMT) 1A from other demyelinating CMTs

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Highlights

- 1. Nerve cross sectional area (CSA) is heterogenous across demyelinating CMTs, despite the overlap in nerve conduction study data.
- 2. Average nerve CSA is significantly enlarged in CMT1A vs. other demyelinating CMTs.
- 3. The large CSA spectrum in CMT1A may be related to its clinical variability.

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
