Highlights

- The Australian healthcare system is challenged by the rising health expenditure, chronic conditions and the duplication of insurance coverage and service provision.
- Our proposed *Mandatory Integrated (Public and Private) Health Insurance (MIPPHI) Model* theoretically aims at improving the sustainability and the efficiency of the Australian chronic and long-term care through 22 policy actions.
- Further work would be required to design and develop an implementation strategy for Australia.
