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Childhood Emotional Abuse, Physical Abuse, and Neglect are Associated with Theory of Mind Decoding Accuracy in Young Adults with Depression

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Highlights

- In the depressed group, emotional abuse was related to poorer theory of mind decoding.
- In the non-depressed group, physical abuse was related to poorer theory of mind decoding.
- Those reporting neglect showed better theory of mind decoding than those without.

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
