ACCEPTED MANUSCRIPT

Highlights:

- Children with ADHD with tic disorder showed increased levels of persistence and self-directedness compared to children with ADHD without tic disorder.
- Temperamental and character profiles (novelty seeking, persistence, and self-directedness) were useful for discriminating children with ADHD from the controls.
- Temperament and character profiles (persistence, self-directedness) that discriminate children with ADHD according to comorbid tic disorder was relatively low.
