Highlight

- This paper reported PTSD was a mediator in the relationship of earthquake-related exposure and quality of life among adolescents survived from Wenchuan earthquake.
- The trauma of Wenchuan earthquake is associated with multidimensional impairment in long-term quality of life among senior high school students.
- Age and female is associated with an increased risk on quality of life.

• Our findings suggested that the early intervention of PTSD in adolescents is a practicable way to improve long-term quality of life.
