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Highlights

- <u>Key finding 1:</u> Despite the current general belief, we could not demonstrate a statistically significant association between the <u>total</u> stressful life events during the preceding 3 years and MS risk.
- <u>Key finding 2</u>: We found evidence confirming the possible role of some <u>individual</u> stressful life events i.e. divorce and homeless periods as potential risk factors for MS while getting married as protective factor for MS.
- These associations were all adjusted for age, gender, physical activity, tobacco smoking, and alcohol drinking

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
