### Highlights

- I use a large and sudden public wage increase to estimate public wage spillovers in Hungary
- The public wage premium changed from -17 to +7.5 percent overnight
- Spillover proxied by ratio of public workers in gender-experience-occupation-region segments
- Firm spillover measured by average individual spillover
- Both spillovers raise the wages of public-type workers
