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

Successful treatment of penile condyloma acuminata accompanied with lichen planus with photodynamic therapy

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Highlights

- Condyloma acuminata and lichen planus are different cutaneous diseases with disparate etiologies. Simultaneous appearance of two diseases in the same area is rare. This report aims to share the clinical and pathological features of a rare case; introduce the effective and safe therapy of it so as to broaden the therapeutic spectrum of Photodynamic Therapy (PDT) indications.
- PDT has its therapeutic advantages in cutaneous diseases, especially inflammatory
 disorders, tissue proliferative diseases such as CA and malignant tumors. Limited side
 effects and low recurrence are two significant advantages of noninvasive ALA-PDT. This
 case shows that topical PDT appears to be a viable option for the treatment of CA with
 LP and adds another application to ALA-PDT.
