- Hyalinizing clear cell carcinoma (HCCC) is a rare tumor
- We present the first case of HCCC arising from the trachea
- Malignant airway obstructions should be managed bronchoscopically

Abstract

Hyalinizing clear cell carcinomas (HCCC), now referred to as clear cell carcinomas (CCC) by the World Health Organization (WHO), are rare tumors usually arising from the salivary glands of the head and neck. We present the first case of a CCC originating from the trachea. A 66 year-old woman with history of hypertension, former smoker, presented to the emergency department reporting worsening shortness of breath.
