Highlights:

- Non-uniform inlet total pressure has a notable impact on turbine efficiency.
- When the endwall total pressure is higher, the turbine efficiency decline sharply.
- The inlet total pressure profile affect the downstream flow pattern directly.
- The fluid near the pressure side is easily affected by the inlet pressure gradient.
- Non-uniform pressure condition has a similar impact on NGV and stage.
