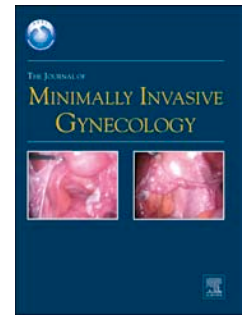

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The Essure procedures were outside of the Saskatchewan provincial health plan, support for the study from Bayer consisted of reimbursement of all of the following:

Physician fee for placement  
Operating room fee  
HSG fee on day of placement  
HSG fee on day of extirpative surgery  
Ultrasound fee on day of placement

Because the patients were already scheduled to undergo out-patient hysterectomy, all of those charges were covered within their provincial health plan. Bayer had no financial involvement with the costs incurred for the hysterectomy and any subsequent patient encounters.
