



Research Highlights

- > Finds support for examining stranger child abduction according to whether cases were attempted or completed
- ➤ Victims are most vulnerable to being successfully abducted at around 10 years old.
- ➤ Male victims are more likely to be successfully abducted than female victims. This appears to be related to experienced offenders targeting males more often.
- ➤ Older offenders appear to be more persistent than younger offenders.
