Abstract

This study examined familial and peer related factors as predictors of suicidal ideation in school students. Total 2,896 participants were included from Taiwan Youth Project released data, a longitudinal survey of adolescent suicidal ideation at ages 15, 18, and 20. Logistic regression analysis risk factors associated with adolescent suicidal
