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State Divestment and Tuition at Public Institutions

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Highlights

- Estimates the pass-through rate of state budget cuts to tuition revenue at public schools.
- Identification strategy accounts for institution-specific factors as well as endogenous state budget choices.
- I find that for every \$1,000 per student state budget cut, the average student pays \$257 more in tuition/fees.
- This rate has increased over time, with a post-2000 pass-through rate of \$318 per student for a \$1,000 cut.

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
