### **Highlights:**

- Study investigates user dilemma in Hedonic Utilitarian choice of software features
- Users favor Utilitarian over Hedonic features in explicit acquisition choice
- However, their implicit acquisition choice is for the Hedonic features
- In forfeiture situation the choice is not dependent on Hedonic and Utilitarian characteristics
- This dichotomy has interesting practical and theoretical implications
