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**Abstract** 

Background: Variations in the functionality, content and form of electronic medical record systems

(EMRs) challenge national roll-out of these systems as part of a national strategy to monitor HIV

response. To enforce the EMRs minimum requirements for delivery of quality HIV services, the Kenya

Ministry of Health (MoH) developed EMRs standards and guidelines. The standards guided the

recommendation of EMRs that met a preset threshold for national roll-out.

Methods: Using a standards-based checklist, six review teams formed by the MoH EMRs Technical

Working Group rated a total of 17 unique EMRs in 28 heath facilities selected by individual owners

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
