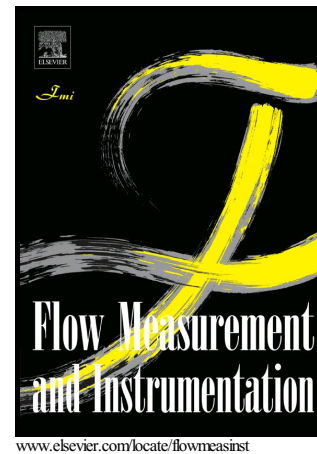

Many watershed studies rely on pressure transducers to measure and report stream and groundwater levels in order to characterize the hydrology of the region.
