- 1. In our experiment a "contribution phase" is followed by a "network phase"
- 2. In the contribution phase, individuals decide whether or not to contribute
- 3. During network formation, individuals decide whether to link thereby exchanging contributions
- 4. Participants can identify themselves in which case others may learn their contribution
- 5. Revealing one's identity promotes the establishment of fewer but more valuable links
