Highlights

- We consider the GPA based admission system to college in Denmark.
- The system affects the timing of college enrollment and not the college-going decision.
- The system affects the timing of family formation.
- We show that the timing of college enrollment is an important determinant hereof.
- Delays in the educational system can have large effects on family decision-making.
