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*Highlights (for review)

- 1. The granular medium evolves from a static to a turbulent regime
- 2. The system exhibits the coexistence of three regions in different flow regimes
- 3. Cooperative dynamics of intruders is necessary for the formation of the flow regimes
- 4. Lacunarity and fractal dimension are useful tools to characterize structural changes
- 5. Our method is useful to monitor processes in industry to improve quality of products

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
