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- The global visa free network is assortative and therefore its architecture highly depends on the collaboration and mutual interactions of nations.
- The community detection of the global network indicates that the world possesses four plus one main communities.
- Regional effects are clearly observed in the construction of the communities.
- The highest internal friendship goes for the community of developed countries, while the lowest goes for the community of the old eastern European blocks, the middle eastern countries, and the not-too-defunct Soviet union.

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
