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Title: Pro-poor growth in East Africa

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Highlights: Pro-poor growth in East Africa

- most of the spells were poverty reducing (positive growth with poverty reduction)
- in most of such spells, the poor benefited less from growth than the non-poor
- the only case of a relative pro-poor growth was identified in Rwanda in 2005–2010
- poorest population benefited generally less than those closer below the poverty line
- Tanzania, followed by Uganda and Rwanda, achieved the highest poverty reduction

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
