Highlights

We calculate emission reduction potentials resulting from technology exchange.

We consider multiple upstream production inputs and supply chains.

We apply linear optimization to exchange MRIO based sectoral production technologies.

We find that CO₂ emissions could theoretically be reduced by more than 10 gigatons.

Even second-tier production technologies hold large reduction potentials.
