

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## Structural change and productivity growth in Mexico, 1990-2014

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### HIGHLIGHTS

- The Mexican economy has experienced structural change and successful insertion into global markets.
- Yet productivity growth has been modest, leading to low and volatile economic growth.
- Employment flows from sectors with high labor productivity growth towards those with lower or contracting growth.
- Highly qualified production factors have not showed a significant contribution to value added growth.

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
