### Highlights

- A Leaking CO<sub>2</sub> Tolerance Index (LCTI) was developed and tested on four plants
- Higher LCTI indicates tolerance to high soil CO<sub>2</sub> simulating carbon storage leaks
- Clover was the most tolerant to CO<sub>2</sub> leakage and maize was the most sensitive
- Maize could be a suitable bio-indicator of CO<sub>2</sub> leaks in carbon storage fields
