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Icy Saturnian Satellites: Disk-Integrated UV-IR Characteristics and Links to Exogenic Processes

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
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Highlights

- Combined Cassini data result in hemispheric composite spectra of Saturn's moons.
- Ultraviolet and visible spectral trends are compared with exogenic processes.
- Results are consistent with E ring organics being responsible for coloring the moons.
- Electrons in the tens of keV range may be particularly effective at darkening and reddening.

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
