Abstract

Objective: This study aimed to determine the sociodemographic and health factors that

influence older adults who continue to participate in the workforce.

Methods: Data were collected and evaluated for 1,762 older adults aged 65 years and

older who were living in the community and were enrolled in a population-based study

(FIBRA Network Study). Older adults who participated in the workforce were

compared with those who did not in terms of sociodemographic characteristics, physical

and mental health, and physical functioning and performance in advanced and

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
