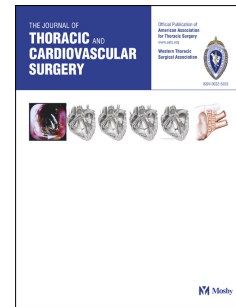


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The significance of the post pericardiotomy syndrome: a real threat or a simple nuisance?
