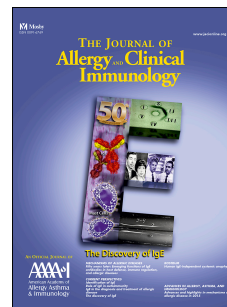

28 *Capsule Summary:* We have found lymph node-like structures termed tertiary lymphoid organs
29 (TLOs) within the mucosa of CRS patients in association with disease recalcitrance and tissue
30 eosinophilia. This finding has potentially important diagnostic, prognostic and therapeutic
31 implications.
