Objective:

To review a single institution's 15 year experience with urethral foreign bodies, including evaluation, clinical findings, and treatment.

Methods:

In total, 27 patients comprising 35 episodes of inserted urethral foreign bodies were reviewed at Cook County Hospital between 2000 and 2015. Retrospective chart review was performed to describe the clinical presentation, rationale for insertion, management, recidivism, and sequelae.
