Abstract

The species of *Charaea* Baly, 1878 from Vietnam, Laos, Thailand, Myanmar and continental Malaysia are revised. Nine species are recognized; apart of *Ch. coomani* (Gressitt & Kimoto, 1963) and *Charaea kelloggi* (Gressitt & Kimoto, 1963) from Vietnam, seven species are described: *Ch. bifurcatum* sp. nov. (Malaysia), *Ch. houaphanicum* sp. nov. (Laos, China: Guangdong), *Ch. jaromiri* sp. nov. (Thailand, Laos), *Ch. langeri* sp. nov. (Myanmar), *Ch. latha* sp. nov. (Laos), *Ch. pytlaki* sp. nov. (Thailand), and *Ch. zaki* sp. nov. (Myanmar). *Charaea coomani* species group is redefined. Colour photographs of habitus and male genitalia, as well as drawings of both male and female genitalia, are presented.
