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
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Spatial variations of the crustal stress field in the Philippine region from inversion of earthquake focal mechanisms and their tectonic implications

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Highlights:

- The spatial variation of the crustal stress for the entire Philippines was revealed.
- The regional E-W σ_I axis coincides with the trench-normal direction.
- The collision of Palawan-PMZ influences the stress state in the western Philippines.
- The Philippine Fault Zone and the oceanic bathymetric highs may alter the stress state.

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
