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Title: Delayed effects of developmental exposure to low levels of the aryl hydrocarbon receptor agonist 3,3',4,4',5-pentachlorobiphenyl (PCB126) on adult zebrafish behavior

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- Developmental exposure to low PCB126 levels causes delayed neurobehavioral effects
- Larval visual-motor behavior was not affected by exposure
- Exposed adult zebrafish lacked short and long-term habituation to novel environment
- Cyp1a was induced in exposed embryos and larvae but not adult brains

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
