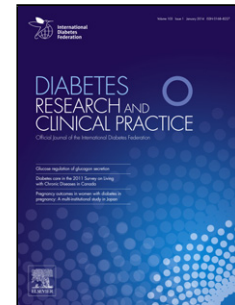


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Title: The changing diagnosis of gestational diabetes mellitus:

- The 2010 IADPSG criteria increase the prevalence of GDM overall
- Using IADPSG criteria, 3.4% patients will be recategorised from GDM to NGT

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
