### Highlights

- Fenton-like reaction generates powerful oxidative species as HO.
- These free radicals may be generated *in situ* by taking advantage of iron and cupper in the biofilm.
- Disinfection of biofilms is very efficient even at pH 5 by adding  $H_2O_2$  in a corroded cast iron pipes.
