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HIGHLIGHTS

- 1. Late Pleistocene–Holocene deposits are widespread in the Amazonian lowland
- 2. This sedimentary record is key for revealing the evolution of Amazonian rivers
- 3. Existing and new data are key in identifying mechanisms which control the landscape evolution
- 4. Morphostructural features support the hypothesis of deposition due to fault reactivation
- 5. Tectonic activity may have originated from renewed stresses within the South American plate
