## **ACCEPTED MANUSCRIPT**

- Spray drying was used to dehydrate emulsions with different wall materials.
- WLF relationship was fitted to glass transition and  $\alpha$ -relaxation temperatures.
- Water induced structural variation affected strength of solids (S).
- Systems with carbohydrate-carbohydrate wall materials exhibited higher *S*.
- Carotenoids degradation depended on S and layer-by-layer interfacial structure.
