Highlights

- Affect dispositions may explain clinical outcomes independent of psychosis symptoms
- Our participants exhibited low levels of positive affect
- Positive affect was unrelated to demographic or psychosis symptom variables
- Negative affect was related to being male, single, and generally distressed
