Highlights

- BD patients show aberrant facial displays of emotion when viewing unpleasant pictures
- BD patients gaze away from unpleasant and neutral pictures
- Gazing away may be a possible compensatory response for heightened emotional liability
- These measures provide sensitive tools of abnormal emotional reactivity in BD
