Highlights

- Schizotypy measures are similar concerning positive and negative traits
- Schizotypy measures are highly invariant concerning disorganized traits
- Scale content is invariant despite similar scale-/facet-names
- Schizotypy measures may be comparable via adjusted factors
- Comparison of results requires differentiation of measures
